Assembling, Managing and Working in Interdisciplinary Teams

This session will explore the definitions of “interdisciplinary” at the levels of the organization, the team and the individual. We will examine how adding interdisciplinarity to the mix affects the strategies that can be effective in growing a project to its potential. The considerations that become relevant at the various stages of a project will be discussed from both the point of view of a team leader as well as the point of view of team members. This session is designed to be interactive and inquiry-based; as such it will avoid delivering any hard-and-fast, ubiquitous rules that often break when the team or project context changes.
