## Choosing a Mentor – The Right Match for a Successful Relationship

Dr. Weiss is a professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences and the previous Co-Chair Mentoring for the Development Core at the Miami Center for AIDS Research (CFAR). Since 1985, Dr. Weiss has provided clinical services to individuals living with HIV. She began conducting research on factors associated with optimal health outcomes among HIV-infected women and men in 1994. One of her goals is to mentor people to become mentors in HIV research. She is recognized for her work in adherence to HIV treatment, reduction of sexual risk, and HIV in sub-Saharan African settings. She is the Principal Investigator (P.I.) of NIH funded studies in Zambia, South Africa and Argentina, as well as at the University of Miami.
